# *WELCOME to Boulder City Lodge #1682*

*Welcome Elks and Guests to the “Friendliest Lodge By a Dam Site.” This year Boulder City, Nevada is proud to host the Nevada State Elks Association’s 97<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference. Our little city has a big personality with small-town charm and abundant historical heritage. Lodge #1682 boasts a unique identity. We were formerly the terminal building for TWA in the late 1930’s and 1940’s. When you visit, you will see a Historical Marker located just west of the entrance to the Elks Lodge, at 1217 Nevada Way. The Marker reads:*

*In 1938 Transcontinental and Western Airlines, later Trans World Airlines, began serving Clark County, flying into Bullock Field in Boulder City. The airline believed that flying into Boulder City would be a more lucrative market than nearby Las Vegas and did not want to lease space at the Western Air Express east of Las Vegas. The airport was located here from 1933 until 1990, when a new airport for Boulder City was opened at the current site. This building was built as the terminal for TWA in 1938 and served in that capacity until the airline moved to Las Vegas in 1949. In 1958, Boulder City Lodge #1682 of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks purchased the building. Since then, the lodge has operated the building as its home, maintaining the historic structure. Visit our conference room for more historical facts and photos.*

*Many Elk friends have visited our lodge to enjoy friendly hospitality as they passed through our town or attended previous conventions. We are excited for you to see some updated changes we’ve made as we strive to meet the needs of a wider demographics and 1,000+ members. 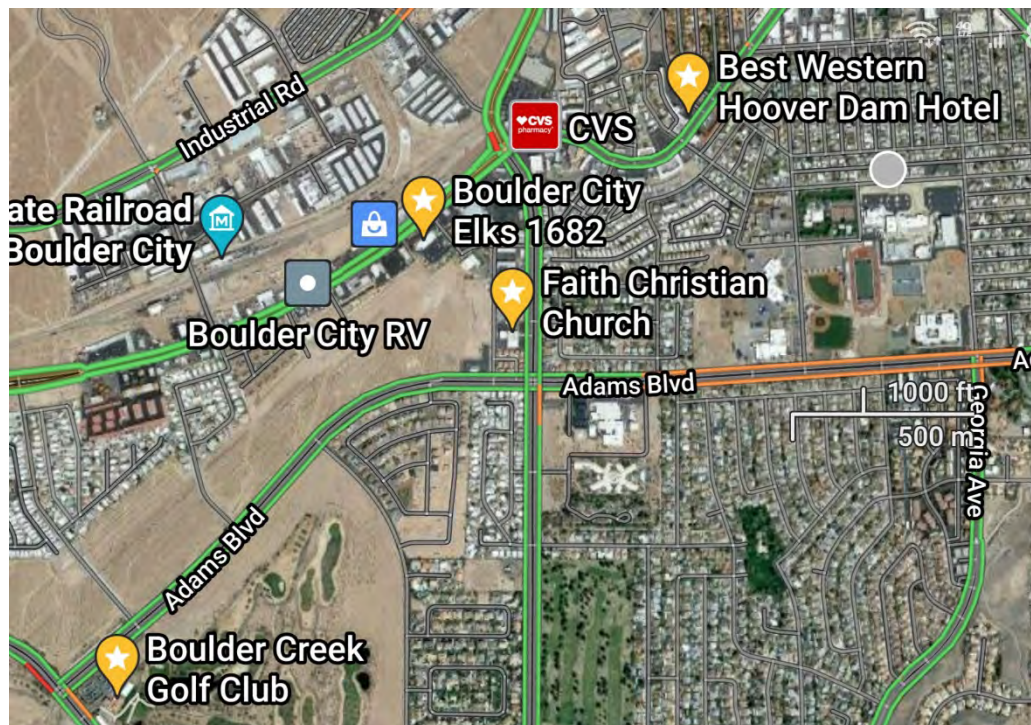
